2020-21 雪菲爾菁英計畫簡章

計畫簡介

因近年臺灣學生於英國雪菲爾大學表現亮眼，英國雪菲爾大學國際學院特別規劃「雪菲爾菁英計畫」，以彈性的入學條件及獎學金，特許符合條件之臺灣學生可於高三下學期（三月）進入雪菲爾大學就讀兩期制大學預科課程，九月即可直升大一，三年後即可取得大學文憑，讓有意留學海外的優秀學生，不僅輕鬆接軌國際，省時更省錢。

英臺學制大不同

有別於臺灣高中三年學制，英國高中採四年學制，並於高中期間最後兩年加強專業科目課程。因此，英國各大學成立國際部，安排國際預科課程，以利國際學生順利銜接英國大學學業。所以，無論是在臺灣還是英國念書，完成高中與大學學業總需時間是一樣的。

獎學金

凡是錄取「雪菲爾菁英計畫」並前往雪菲爾大學國際學院就讀之學生，每人至少獲得 1,000 英鎊獎學金，若參加 11 月獎學金甄選會，可獲得獎學金 2,500-6,000 英鎊，甄選會相關辦法另行公布。

錄取條件

1. 雅思 IELTS UKVI 學術組 6.0，單科不得低於 5.0。
2. 高一和高二在校成績平均 65-70 分，數學及英文不得低於 75-80 分，其他科不得低於 60 分。
3. 少數特殊科系需繳交作品集，詳情可另外諮詢。
